

AIR NAVIGATION ORDER 2005



EXEMPTION

DROPPING WATER/CHEMICAL ON FOREST FIRES

1. The Civil Aviation Authority, ("the CAA") in exercise of its powers under Article 153 of the Air Navigation Order 2005, hereby exempts **any** helicopter, hereinafter called "the helicopter", for the time being operated by **PLM Dollar Group Limited**, from the provisions of Article 66(2) of the said Order.
2. This Exemption is granted subject to the following conditions:-
 - a) any flight shall be made only over **the land controlled by the organisation contracting such flights**;
 - b) any flight shall be in accordance with the Company's **Aerial Work Operations Manual Section 10** and any articles shall be dropped within the area described in sub para 2(a); and
3. This Exemption shall be valid, during the daylight hours from **01 August 2007** until **31 July 2009**, both dates inclusive, unless previously varied, suspended or revoked.
